- Proof of Comprehensive Liability Insurance naming the City of Johns Creek as a certificate holder: *The insurance requirement minimum is \$1,000,000 per occurrence and 2,000,000 per aggregate for commercial general liability and liquor liability, \$1,000,000 minimum automobile liability per occurrence and in aggregate, and Worker's Compensation Insurance pursuant to statutory requirements.*
- Use of 20 x 20 tent or larger call (678) 512-3363 for approval by Fire Marshall.

Rules and Regulations

➤ **License requirements -- Resident caterers.**

- Resident caterers must hold a valid Off Premise Caterers License.
- In order to distribute or sell malt beverages, wine or distilled spirits at an authorized catered function, a licensed alcoholic beverage caterer shall file an application for an off-premises event permit (Form R154) to the city at no additional fee.
- Excise taxes are imposed upon the sale of alcoholic beverages by a resident caterer.

➤ **Permit requirements -- Nonresident caterers.**

- A nonresident alcoholic beverage caterer is required to submit an application for an off-premises event permit to the City.
- The original off-premises event permit shall be kept in the vehicle transporting the alcoholic beverages to the catered event or function.
- It shall be unlawful for a licensed alcoholic beverage caterer to distribute, sell, or otherwise dispense alcoholic beverages off-premises except as authorized by the off-premises event permit.
- Excise taxes are imposed upon the total of individual alcoholic beverage drinks served by a nonresident caterer in the amounts set forth in the Code of the City of Johns Creek and shall be paid within 30 days after the conclusion of the catered event or function.

➤ A licensed alcoholic beverage caterer may sell or otherwise dispense only that which is authorized by his alcoholic beverage license. For example, if the alcoholic beverage caterer possesses a valid license to sell malt beverages, he may sell or otherwise dispense only malt beverages at the authorized catered event or function.

➤ *Sunday sales.* An alcoholic beverage caterer wishing to cater an event or function on Sunday must possess a valid Sunday sales license and comply with the requirements of state law with respect to the service of alcoholic beverages on Sunday.

As a condition on the issuance of a Special Occasion Permit, the licensee shall indemnify and hold the City harmless from claims, demand or cause of action which may arise from activities associated with the special occasion event.
