The Johns Creek Veterans Association (JCVA) strives to honor and remember those who served or are serving in any capacity in the United States military. One of the JCVA's primary projects was the creation of the Johns Creek Veterans Memorial Walk.

The memorial offers a contemplative place for people to pause and remember the men and women who served their country. It serves as a place for patriotic events in Johns Creek.

Located on five acres at Newtown Park, the Veterans Memorial Walk features a handicap-accessible, landscaped trail with black granite memorials focusing on each conflict dating to World War I, Purple Heart recipients, POW/MIAs, and Women in Service. The Veterans Memorial Walk includes granite benches, an entrance plaza, a gazebo, a ceremonial bell monument, and a fountain.

The Memorial Walk stands as a symbol of cooperation between the City and the Johns Creek Veterans Association. It reflects the support of our veterans by Johns Creek citizens and its businesses.

The granite monuments and quiet surroundings are not a place to celebrate war, but to reflect on the peace we enjoy as a result of sacrifices and hardships endured by our brave men and women in uniform.

THE WALL THAT HEALS

The Wall That Heals is a half-scale replica of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C. The Wall was installed and opened to the public in 2020.

As on The Wall, the names on The Wall That Heals are listed by day of casualty. Beginning at the center/apex, the names start on the East Wall (right-hand side) working their way out to the end of that wing, picking up again at the far end of the West Wall (left-hand side) and working their way back in to the center/apex, joining the beginning and end of the conflict at the center.

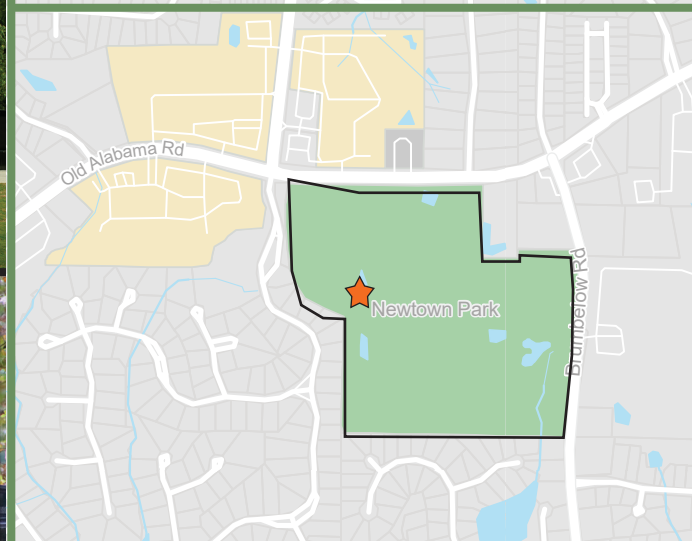
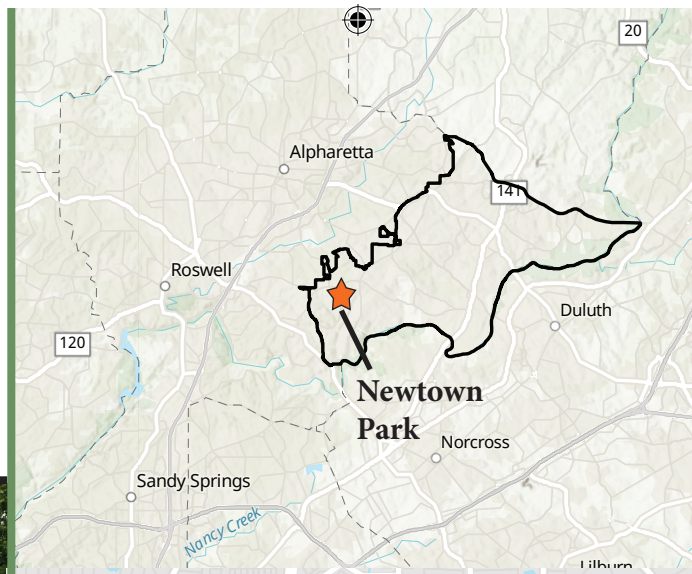
